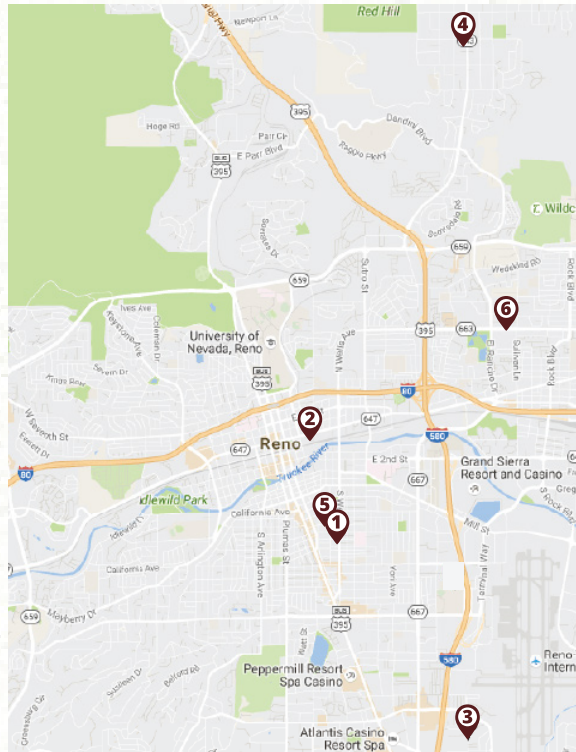

Your Payment Options

We do our best to provide you with appropriate payment options for you and your family. We ask that you pay for all medical and dental services at the time you receive them. We accept cash, credit cards, debit cards, checks and most private insurances, as well as Medicare and Medicaid . We also have a payment plan available. C.H.A. charges for services on a sliding fee scale, which is based on income and family size. To qualify, fill out the sliding fee application located on our website.
